Invited rehearsals provide students and instructors with a rare glimpse at the creative process of the Los Angeles Philharmonic as they prepare for a concert performance. As part of the experience, ensembles will gain first-hand insight into the rehearsal process, information on the repertoire and composers, and participate in a dynamic and interactive workshop.

Program overview

- Attend one invited rehearsal with the Los Angeles Philharmonic at Walt Disney Concert Hall
- Participate in an interactive pre-rehearsal activity, guided by a team of LA Phil Teaching Artists
- Interface directly with members of the Los Angeles Philharmonic*
- There is no fee for participation; all costs are underwritten by the Los Angeles Philharmonic Association

Eligibility

- Open only to school or extra-curricular music ensembles with players in middle and/or high school (grades 6-12)
- Must be an instrumental music ensemble (Jazz, wind ensemble, orchestra, chamber ensembles, etc. are all welcome)
- Successful applicant ensembles must commit to providing their own ground transportation to and from Walt Disney Concert Hall for the rehearsal
- Exemplary audience etiquette is expected

Complete application must include:

1. Application form, to be completed by the ensemble director with optional student input (see below)
2. ONE letter of support from any of the following individuals: school principal, senior school administrator, board member, Executive Director, or similar
3. ONE video recording (see section III.)
4. Responses to short-answer questions (see section IV.)
